Neuromuscular dentistry is the physiologic groundwork that blends function and esthetics. The teeth are responsible for the shape and form of the lips and cheeks. Dark circles under the eyes are often due to an unhealthy neuromuscular position.

Health and function must be carefully blended to achieve the ultimate in facial form. There is a special look that is reflected in symmetry of the total facial complex. The teeth are an important organ of the body that effect not just how we smile but how we communicate our feelings, how we breathe and how we enjoy the subtle gustatory nuances of food and wine. They change our facial expressions and how other people read our faces. Overclosure of the bite can lead to unhappy or angry appearance due to the drooping at the corner of the lips. They change how we see ourselves and that can change how we feel.

Dr Ira Shapira and Dr Mark Amidei are general dentists who have extensive training in neuromuscular and cosmetic dentistry. They recognize that oral health can effect total health and treat TMJ disorders and airway obstruction that leads to snoring and sleep apnea.
